# **RULES FOR PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION**

- 1. The photograph must be one of the categories given, printed on entrant's choice of paper on no smaller than an A4 size.
- 2. If required, the Waikato A&P Show will supply complementary backing paper before displaying for judging please be aware this could leave a mark on your photograph.
- 3. Competitor must have name and category on back of each photograph
- 4. All fees need to be paid to the Waikato A&P Assn by October 21st, 2022 (account details on entry form)
- 5. All photos need to be delivered either through post or brought into the Waikato A&P office no later than Friday, October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022.
- 6. All entries will be available for collection as of 4<sup>th</sup> November from the office at 800 Heaphy Terrace
  - If required to be posted or couriered back to exhibitor after completion, then please enclose a prepaid self-addressed envelope of suitable size.
- 7. Photos can be coloured or black and white. Entries will be judged by a suitably qualified person.
- 8. A public choice of best overall photograph will be a separate competition. Refer to Prize Section.
- 9. The competitor remains as sole owner of the photograph, however the competitor agrees to allow at no cost to the organisers of the Waikato A&P Show the right to have copies of the photograph made and used for future promotional purposes.
- 10. The Waikato A&P Show will endeavour to protect the photographs from any damage or theft at all times, however, the competitor accepts full responsibility of any said loss.
- 11. Judging will take place the week of the Show and winners will be displayed all weekend of the event. The event team will contact winners post event.
- 12. The judge's decision will be final, and no correspondence or discussions will be entered into thereafter.
- 13. Waikato A&P reserve the right not to display all entries if categories are oversubscribed.

## **Payment Terms & Conditions**

Prize money will be paid by direct banking within four weeks i.e. 25/11/2022. You will be contacted by the Show organisers to confirm bank details. If you have not received your prize money by this date please notify the office immediately. Notification must be made no later than the 2/12/22. Notification after this date will not be considered.
